- ~ 97% consider the pet a member of the family













FIG. 2 Share of aggregate income held by US middle class has plunged since 1970. Note: Households are assigned to income tiers based on their size-adjusted income in the calendar year before the survey year. Their unadjusted incomes are then totaled to compute the share of US aggregate household income held by each income tier. Shares may not add to 100% due to rounding. (From Kochhar R, Sechopoulos S. How the American middle class has changed in the past five decades. Pew Research Center. April 20, 2022. Accessed January 5, 2023. https://www.pewresearch.org/fact-tank/2022/04/20/how-the-american-middle-class-has-changed-in-the-past-five-decades/. Source: Pew Research Center analysis of the current population survey, annual social and economic supplement (IPUMS).)






### **Generational Pet Household Distribution**




# Why Was This Study Done?

Lack of empirical research on racial disparities in animal welfare


Research on animal welfare has been "animal-centric"

Conducting a study with empirical rigor can contribute to positive change in the animal welfare industry






#### Adopted Pet from Animal Shelter or Rescue Group





# Overall, what are your feelings about the animal shelter in your community?






### Where did you get your pet?






# Been Turned Down by Animal Shelter or Rescue Group when Tried to Adopt a Pet






### Reasons for Not Being Able to Adopt






# Overall, what are your feelings about animal control in your community?






### Law Enforcement or Animal Control Officers in My Community Take Away Pets to Punish the Owners






# Law Enforcement or Animal Control Officers are More Likely to Take Away Pets from Pet Owners of Color than from Pet Owners Who are White

### Barriers to Adoption


"When I first started (18 years ago) you had to:


